# PROGRAM NOTES

## **Selections from Wicked**

In 2004 Broadway was taken by storm by the hit show "Wicked." The story line of how the Wicked Witch of the West met Glinda the Witch of the North is intriguing, and the music is filled with depth and beauty. This powerful medley includes: No One Mourns the Wicked; Dancing Through Life; Defying Gravity; No Good Deed and For Good.

## **Chorale and Toccata**

Chorale and Toccata uses many 20th Century compositional techniques studied by the composer. The work is written in a traditional style with a main chorale melody, a Toccata them, and a recurring chordal motif which binds the Toccata. During the Toccata, the main them is used in inversion and appears in a double canon with its inversion. The Chorale then returns toward the end of the work to complete the cyclic idea.

## **Follow the River**

This haunting and distinctive work is based on a novel by James Alexander Thom which accounts the life of Mary Ingles who, in 1755, after having escaped Indian captures, tries to find her way home on a thousand mile journey, using the Ohio River as her guide.

## **SANG!**

In SANG!, Wilson uses a wonderful crossover style focused on minimalism and jazz, with rhythmic vocalizations from the players for an added twist. The piece is built of phrases that are repeated over and over throughout, but in various combinations to provide interest and growth.

## **El Capitan**

One of the perennial Sousa favorites, this march has enjoyed exceptional popularity with bands since it first appeared. It was extracted from the most successful of Sousa's operettas, *El Capitan*. Some of the themes appear in more than one act, and the closing theme of the march is the same rousing theme which ends the operetta.
